- 1) You must be enrolling into a post secondary institution for study in the field of agriculture.
 - 2) Proof of enrolment is necessary before funds are awarded.
 - 3) Only students from Eatonia, Eston, Kindersley and Marengo high schools can apply.
 - 4) Only one scholarship will be awarded per year. (Not one per school.
 - 5) You must provide transcripts from grade ten, grade eleven and the first half of grade twelve.
 - 6) In the event of two or more applicants having identical academic standings, then the extent of the applicants community involvement will determine the successful recipient.
 - 7) Deadline for applications is April 30th each year.
