


BYLAW NO. 122


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 242(1)(b) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT 1989

The council of the Rural Municipality of Kindersley No. 290  
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The tankloading facilities operated by R.M. of Kindersley No. 290 are listed below, and this bylaw applies to all of them:
  1. Beadle SW $\frac{1}{4}$  11-29-22-3
  2. Brock SE $\frac{1}{4}$  22-29-20-3
  3. D'Arcy NW $\frac{1}{4}$  07-29-18-3
  4. Flaxcombe SE $\frac{1}{4}$  09-29-26-3
  5. Pinkham SE $\frac{1}{4}$  28-28-25-3
  6. Fairmount NE $\frac{1}{4}$  09-28-24-3
  7. Kindersley SW $\frac{1}{4}$  09-29-23-3
  8. Netherhill NE $\frac{1}{4}$  33-29-21-3
2. No person shall fill any chemical spray apparatus.
3. No person shall fill any tank or container that has been used for solutions other than clear water.
4. There shall be no direct loading from the water supply.
5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 48 is hereby repealed.
