## **ALL HEAVY HAUL TRAFFIC TRAVELLING WITHIN THE R.M. OF KINDERSLEY**

## Rules and Regulations:

- Travel on Dry and Frozen roads only.
- ❖ When weather becomes an issue please use discretion on travel.
- Check our R.M. website on a regular basis for any updates.
- Maximum speed of 70 km per hour.
- There are three roads within our R.M. that are rated for primary weights. The 657 (Brock Gravel) North and South, Rosana Road and Flaxcombe South.
- All other roads, unless posted, are rated secondary.
- Anyone traveling with more than secondary weight must purchase a primary weight permit. The form that needs to be filled out is on the website home page just click the form tab. To see weight chart click highway tab.
  - o Cost of Primary Weight Permits
    - \$50.00 plus GST per move, per unit.
    - \$120.00 plus GST annually, per unit.
      - Annuals will receive a sticker to be placed above your safety sticker on your window for visibility.
- Primary Weight Permits, both daily and annual, must be with the driver at all times while travelling in the R.M.
- No travel within our R.M. until further notice if caught overweight without permit in place.
- Permits may be revoked for non-compliance of permit conditions.
- Slow to 40km when traveling by workers or construction sites.
- Slow to 50km when traveling by residential yard sites.
- No parking on gravel roads, unless an emergency situation should occur.
- No loading on gravel roads at any time.
- No chains on any gravel roads.
- No floater tires on any gravel roads.
- No mud brought onto gravel roads.
- Any incidences that occur on our roads (accidents, etc.) must be reported to Bylaw Enforcement.
- ❖ If any heavy haul units are stuck you must notify Bylaw Enforcement before any effort is made in getting the unit out. At this point a decision will be made on how the situation will be resolved.
- ❖ All Drilling/ Frac Rig moves are to water all roads adjacent to residential yard sites prior to move.

- All Drilling/ Frac/ Service Rigs to notify Bylaw Enforcement prior to move.
- ❖ All Drilling/ Frac/ Service Rigs maximum of 50km by residential yard sites.
- The R.M. will put restrictions on the roads if weather conditions become severe to help maintain our infrastructure. This includes our primary weight roads as well.
- ❖ If any road starts to become damaged due to negligence, we will be forced to put a 10 ton limit on them.
- Anyone caught destroying a road will be responsible for the cost of repairs to the road and subject up to a twenty-five thousand dollar fine (\$25,000.00).
- ❖ Any authorization being requested must be authorized by the Bylaw Enforcement.
