 - salinity control around lagoons
 - tree caps for decommissioned landfill for leachate control
 - forest filters on flood plains below landfills
 - effluent irrigation woodlots and much more

Great News About HELP Current Crop of Tree Seedlings

HELP has produced the largest stem size near double that of the past two crops! In addition, our research/development unit is producing longer roots to create more drought resistant willows.

In addition to all regular varieties, HELP has doubled its production of the trees of highest demand ie: the Prairie Sky and Okanese poplar and has greatly increased its production of all willow varieties, as well as the three principal evergreen varieties of Blue Spruce, White Spruce and Scot's Pine. HELP is also proud to announce the majestic North West Poplar and Bebs Willow as new varieties available for public sale.

1. Pick Up Customers are given 10% additional bonus mixed willow.
2. 100% of customers receive 5% bonus of each variety ordered. If more replants are required within 18 months of purchase, HELP provides the replants at preferred rate of \$1.75 even if under 300 trees.
3. If you are a pick up customer who agrees to transport and hand over other customer trees enroute or at your destination, HELP will pay you \$10 per pail or \$25 per box of tree seedlings that you carry.
4. 5% discount for November, 4% for December, 3% for January, 2% for February and 1% for March.
5. Shipping is payable by customer at 30¢ per seedling (minimum \$40 charge).
6. Tree Seedling Prices remain at \$2.50 per seedling for orders 50 to 290 trees, 300 trees or more (includes any assortment of tree varieties in multiples of ten) the price has increased to \$1.75 per seedling. New category of 20 to 49 trees for \$5.00 per seedling
